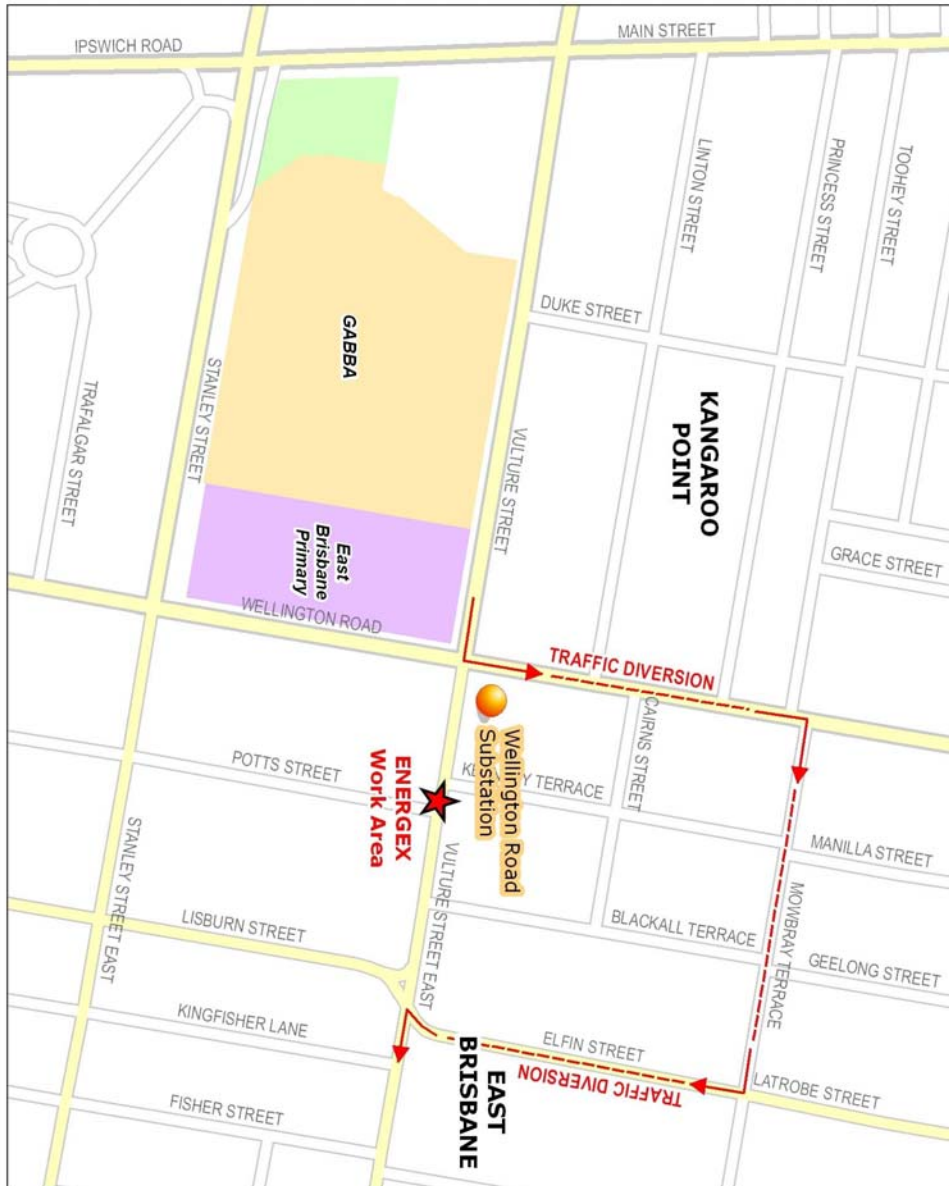


# Map of traffic diversion for Vulture Street East



# Improving your future energy supply



Temporary road closure for Vulture Street East





September 2011

Dear Resident/Business Owner

ENERGEX will be performing essential underground power upgrades across the intersection of Vulture Street East, Potts Street and Kennedy Terrace, East Brisbane. As a result, there will be full lane closures and detour in place between:

- 7pm Friday 23 September 2011 and 5am Monday 26 September 2011
- 7pm Friday 30 September 2011 and 5am Monday 3 October 2011

To ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians during this construction, Vulture Street East will be closed for vehicular traffic between Wellington Road and Blackall Road East Brisbane.

During the road closure a short detour will be in place directing traffic left onto Wellington Road, right onto Mowbray Terrace, right onto Elfin Street then back onto Vulture Street East. The detour will be signed with traffic control officers in place. (see map)

This project, along with several others in the area, are designed to meet the continued growth in electricity usage in Brisbane's South Eastern suburbs.

Such increases are largely due to the area's above average population growth and the increased use of energy intensive appliances such as air conditioners and large screen televisions.

**What to expect during this project**

Businesses and residents are not expected to experience power interruptions due to this work, however, some inconvenience may be experienced such as:

**Full road closure**

Full lane closures will be required during construction. Traffic management staff will operate on site, when required, to ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians.

**Heavy vehicles**

Heavy vehicles such as trucks, cranes and backhoes will be operating in the area during construction.

**Noise disruption**

Local residents may experience some noise disturbances during the excavation and trenching along affected roads.

**STORM SAFETY**

The dangers are real during storm season.

Be prepared and stay away from fallen powerlines.
