

Eastern Busway

Buranda to Main Avenue

Information update April 2011

Edith Street road work

Construction is progressing well for the Eastern Busway (Buranda to Main Avenue) and is on track for early project completion late this year.

From Monday 11 April, work will be undertaken to restore kerbs, footpaths and road surface in Edith Street. Work will be undertaken in two halves, starting with the residential side of the street and is expected to continue for approximately three weeks.

What to expect:

- installation of construction barriers
- use of machinery to remove existing asphalt
- interruptions to driveway access
- trucks and deliveries
- noise associated with the use of machinery
- some vibration when new asphalt is laid.

Every effort will be made to limit the impact on nearby residents. Traffic control officers will be present to assist pedestrians and motorists around the work areas.

This work is subject to suitable weather conditions.

Driveway access

Residents are requested to have their vehicles removed from individual properties **by 7 am each morning**, should they wish to use them during the day. During this work, a temporary parking area (see map below) will be provided for residents' vehicles.

At the end of each working shift, construction crews will re-establish an entry ramp to individual properties for residents to park their cars inside at night, should they wish.
