

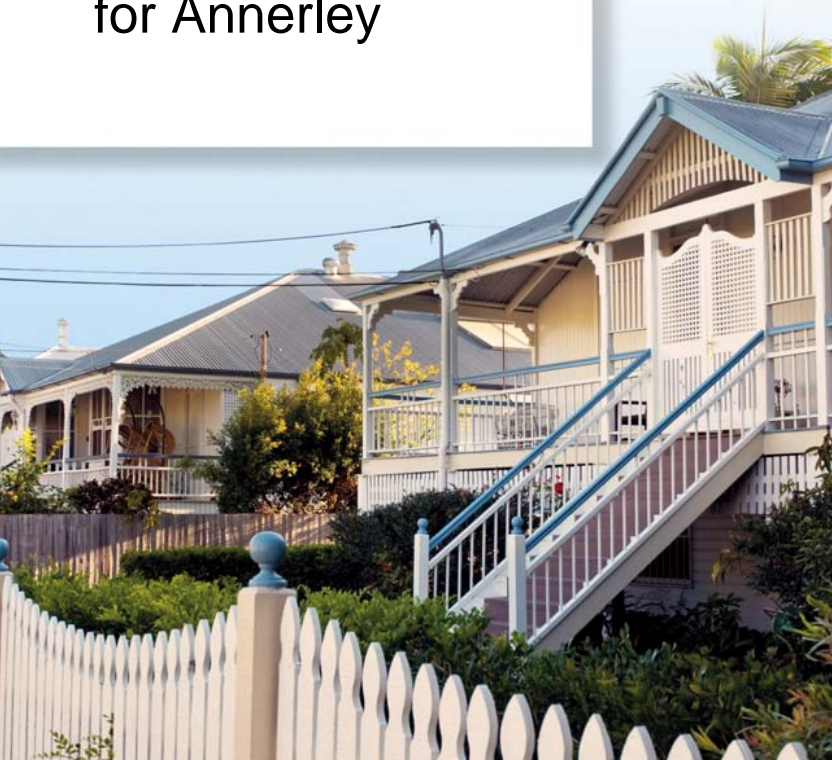

Network upgrade for Annerley



What's happening during the Annerley network upgrade

As part of ENERGEX's \$11 million investment to construct a new substation at Buranda and upgrade the surrounding area's local electricity network, new underground power cables will be installed along a short section of Annerley Road, Annerley, between **early September 2011** and **late October 2011**.

The new cables will be installed in the western side of Annerley Road from Carville Street north to Dutton Park train station in Kent Street (see map right).

Trenches will be excavated along the route and progressively reinstated.



What to expect


Homes and businesses are not expected to experience power interruptions during this work, however, some inconvenience may be experienced such as:

- Noise disruption – work will generally occur between 7am and 6pm, however, after hours work may be required to minimise impact to traffic.
- Partial lane closures – partial lane closures will be required during construction times. Traffic controllers will ensure the safety of motorists and pedestrians.
- Heavy vehicles – construction vehicles such as bobcats and trucks will be entering and leaving work sites.
