Neighbourhood Plan for Coorparoo Junction

Council has commenced community input for the renewal of Coorparoo Junction, Stones Corner and Buranda. The process is known as the Eastern Corridor Renewal.

The completion of the Eastern Busway project will lead to a demand for a mix of homes, businesses, shops and community facilities around the bus stations. Rather than waiting, Council is planning now for this future demand.

Nominations were called for community members to form a Community Planning Team.

"There was an overwhelming response" said Councillor Abrahams. "It was just not possible for everyone to be included."

thriving retail areas once again.

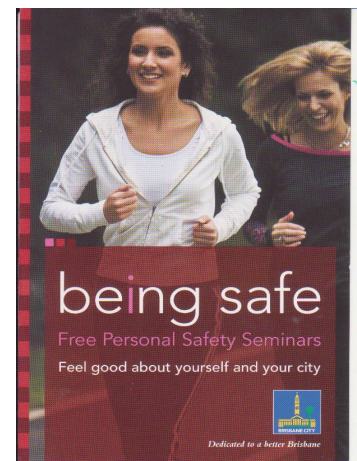
"I will provide regular updates on the progress of the Eastern Corridor Renewal through e-newsletters and my website" said Cr Abrahams.
